





## Road Safety Links to Numeracy



KEY OBJECTIVES	POSSIBLE ACTIVITY
Count reliably up to 10 everyday objects	<ul> <li>Count how many people can be seen in a picture crossing a road, and discuss crossing safely.</li> </ul>
Recognise numerals 1 to 9	Recognise the numerals on a car number plate, and identify and count the number of other parts of a car, e.g. seatbelts, mirrors, wheels etc. Discuss their use.
Use language such as 'more' or 'less', 'greater' or 'smaller', 'heavier' or 'lighter', to compare two number or quantities	Look at a picture of a busy high street and use appropriate language to discuss what can be seen, e.g. "Which is bigger, the bus or the car?"
Talk about, recognise and recreate simple patterns	Talk about the pattern on a zebra crossing and use painting to recreate the pattern. Discuss the purpose of a crossing.
Use everyday words to describe position	<ul> <li>Follow a simple route,         either directly or with a 'roamer'         (programmable floor turtle),         using verbal instructions.         E.g. "turn left" go "behind" etc.</li> </ul>
